

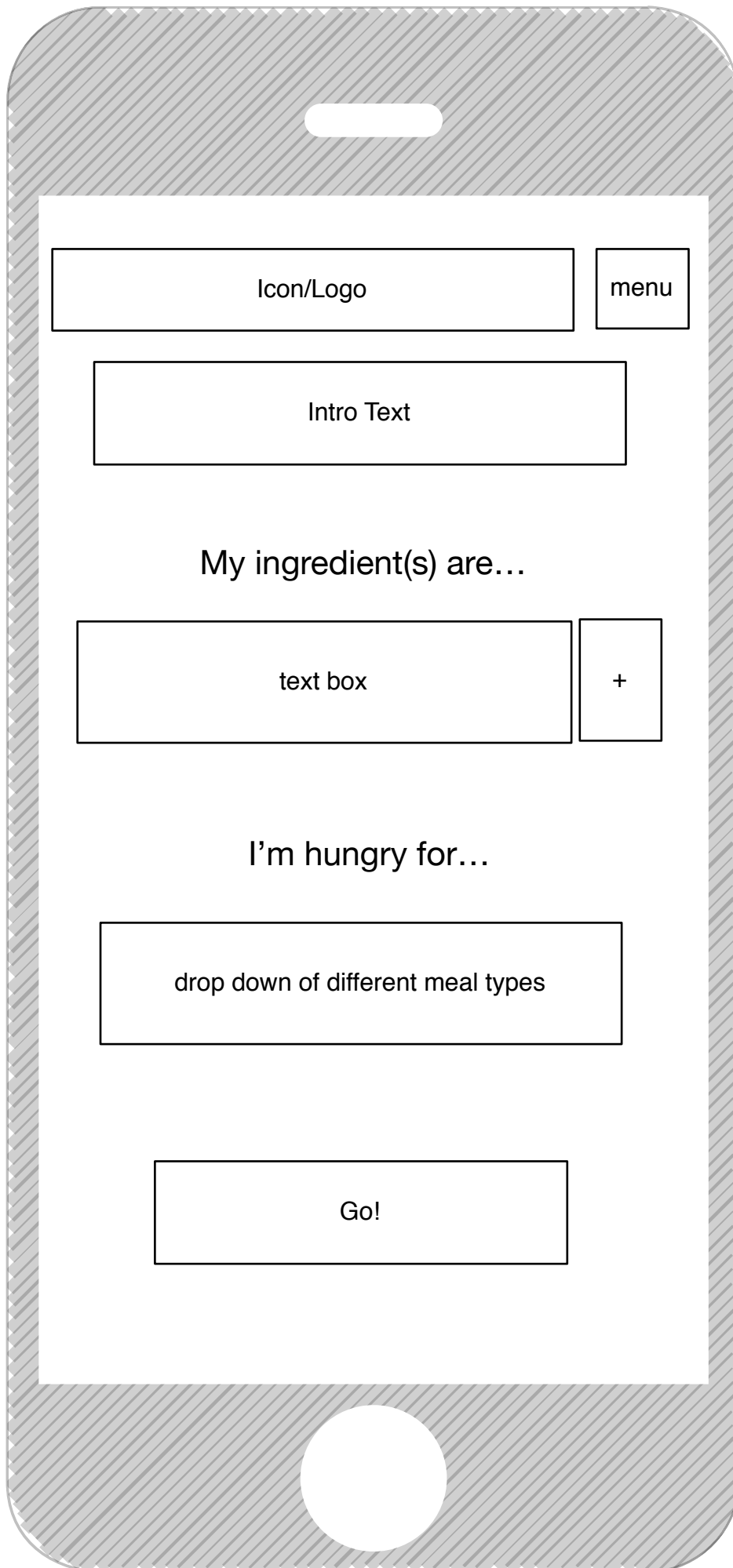
0.0 - Homescreen

Notes:

This is the intro screen where users input data that will determine how they navigate through the rest of the app. It is meant to serve as an introduction to the product, but also allows them to immediately begin usage. A hidden navigation, accessible by swiping at the top right, will grant them immediate access to saved search results, favorites, and notes if they are looking to retrieve archived data.

Users can also “add” multiple ingredients to their search criteria, and the screen will automatically adjust to accommodate those additions.

When searching for a meal type, users will be able to scroll through a short drop down that lists Breakfast, Brunch, Lunch, Snacks, or Dinner

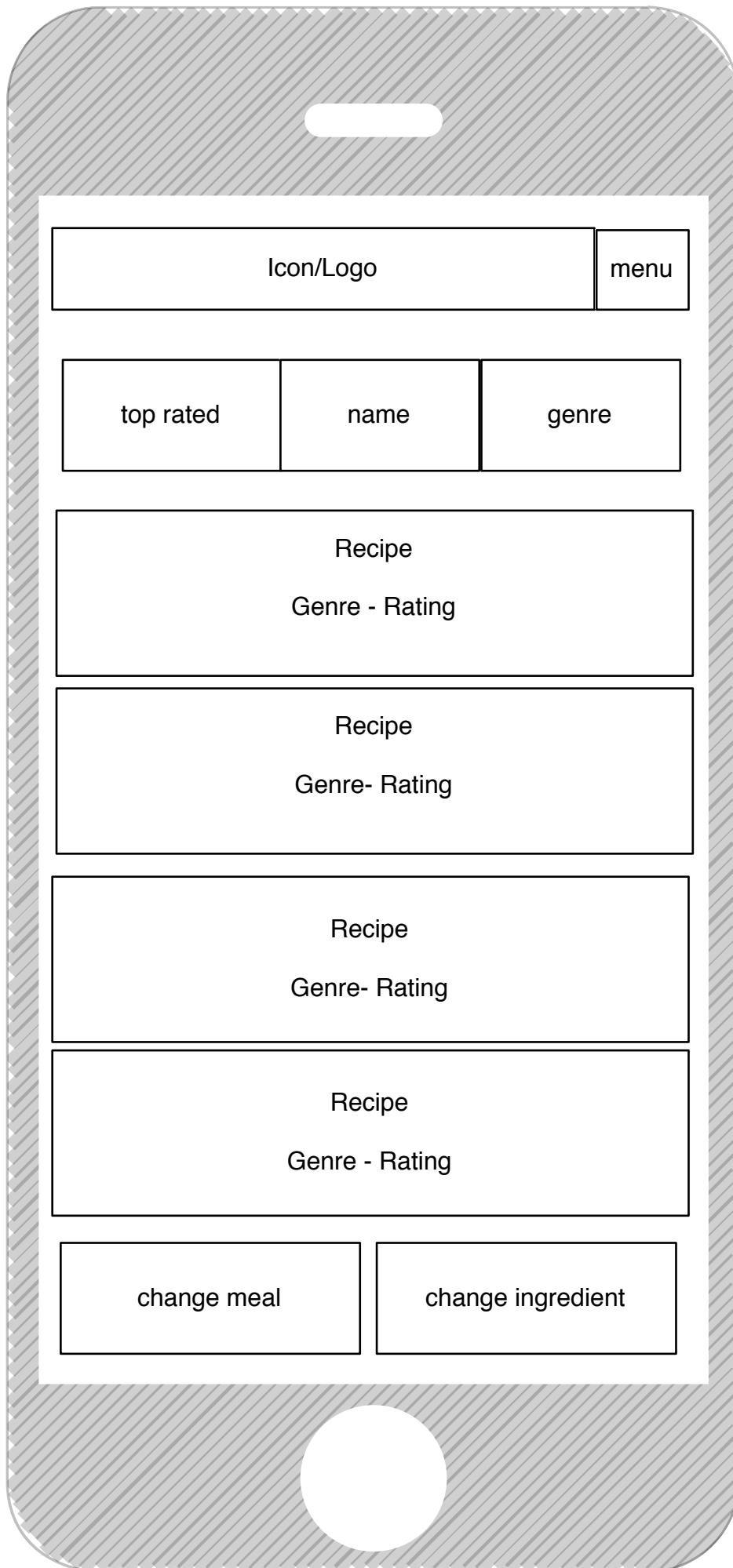


1.0 and 1.12- Recipe Listings

Notes:

This screen will list recipes that match the ingredients and meal type indicated via the search made on the homescreen. Users can access the recipe by swiping to the left.

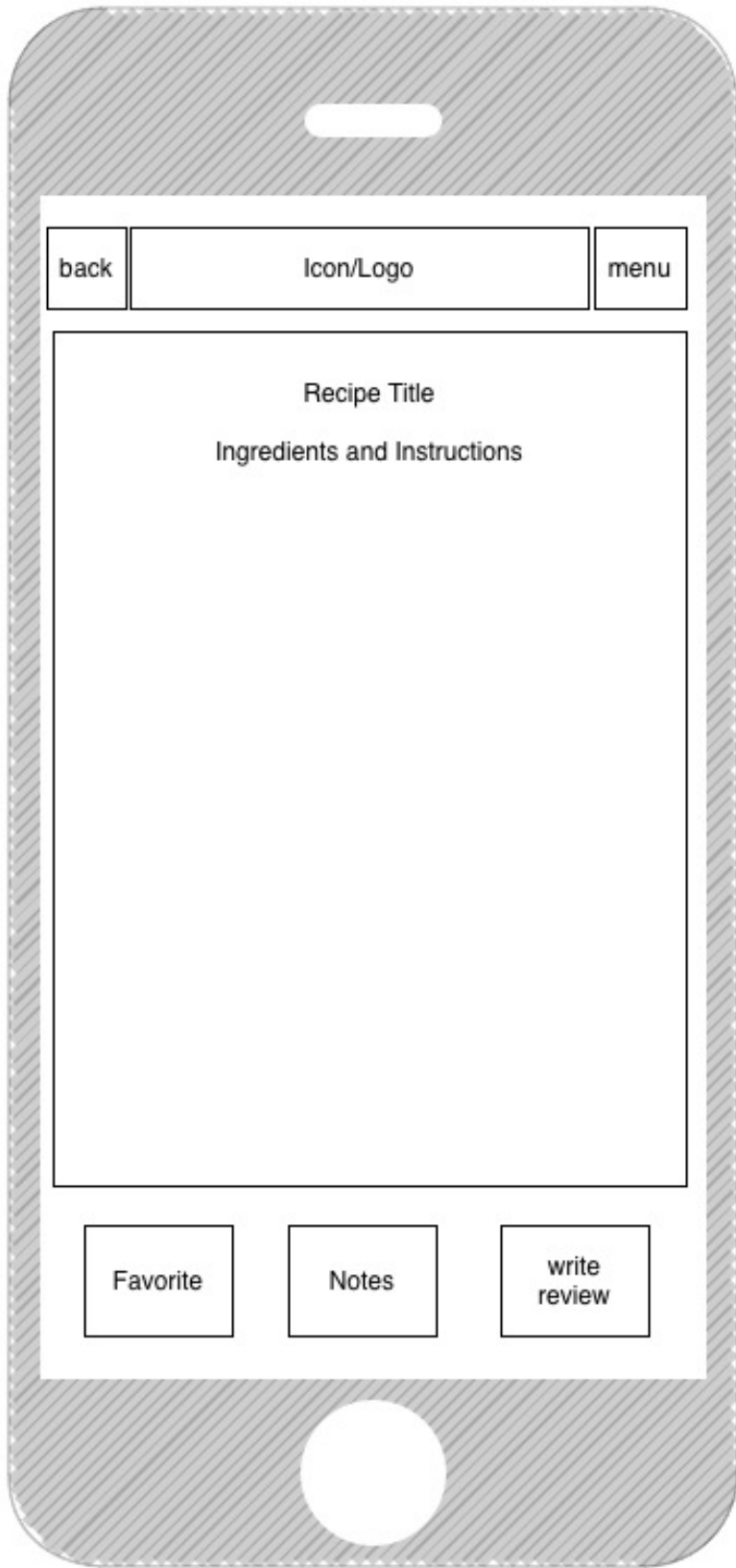
Users can sort recipes via rating, name or genre . They can also elect to change meal type of ingredients via bar at bottom

Notes:

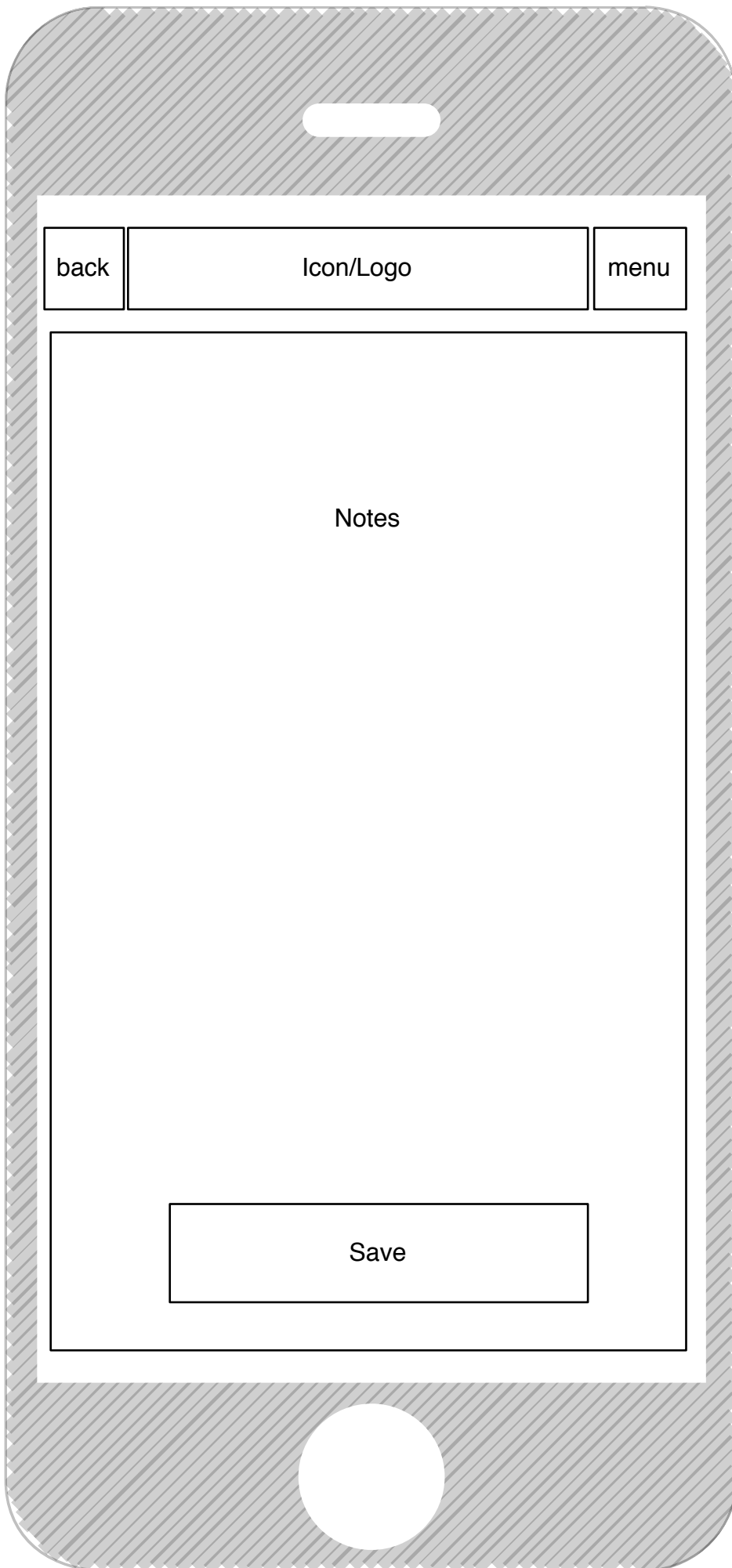
This screen displays a selected recipe. Users can also favorite the recipe, take notes on it, or write a review. A back arrow on top left allows them to navigate back to their search.

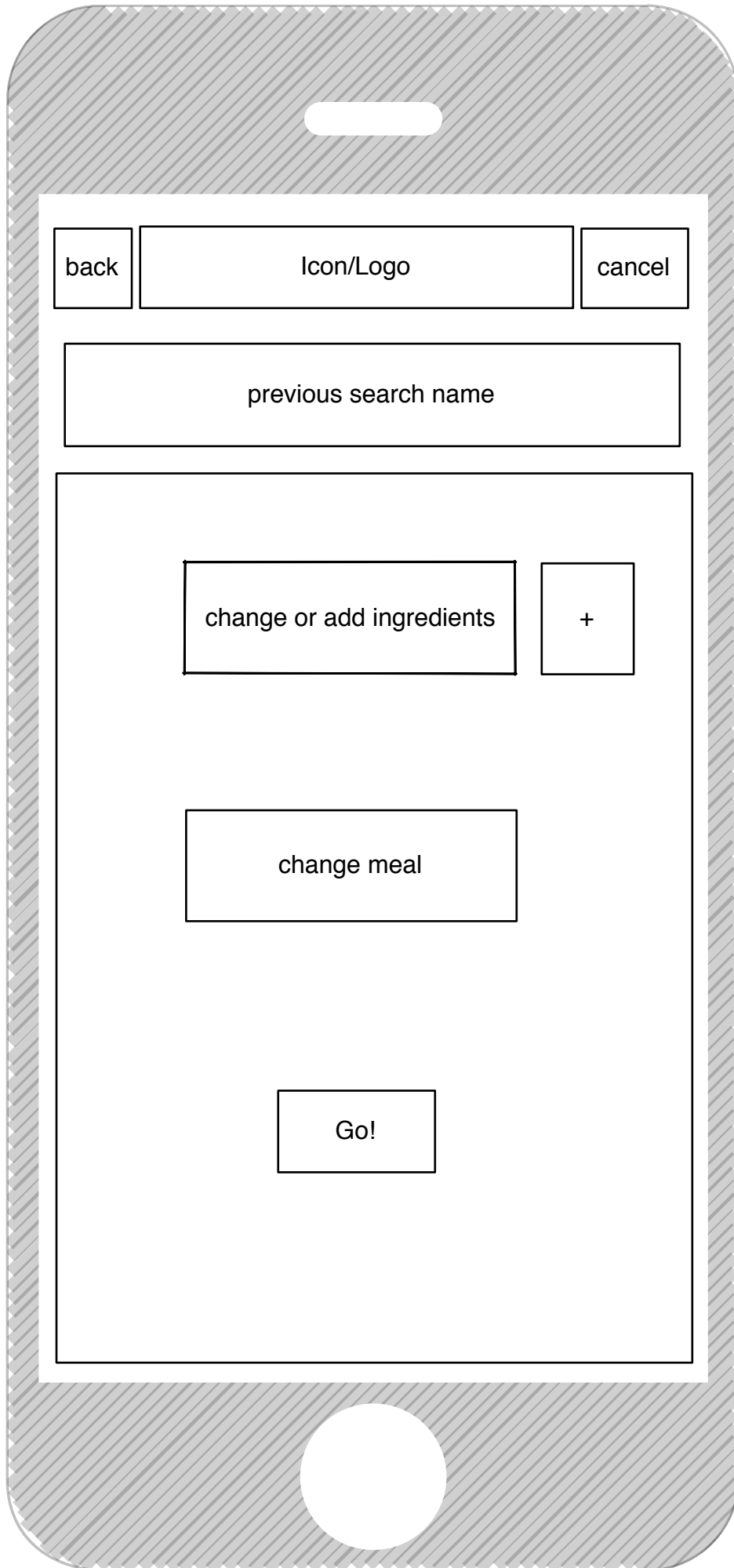
This is a very simple screen where users can take notes. Save button at bottom.

Notes:

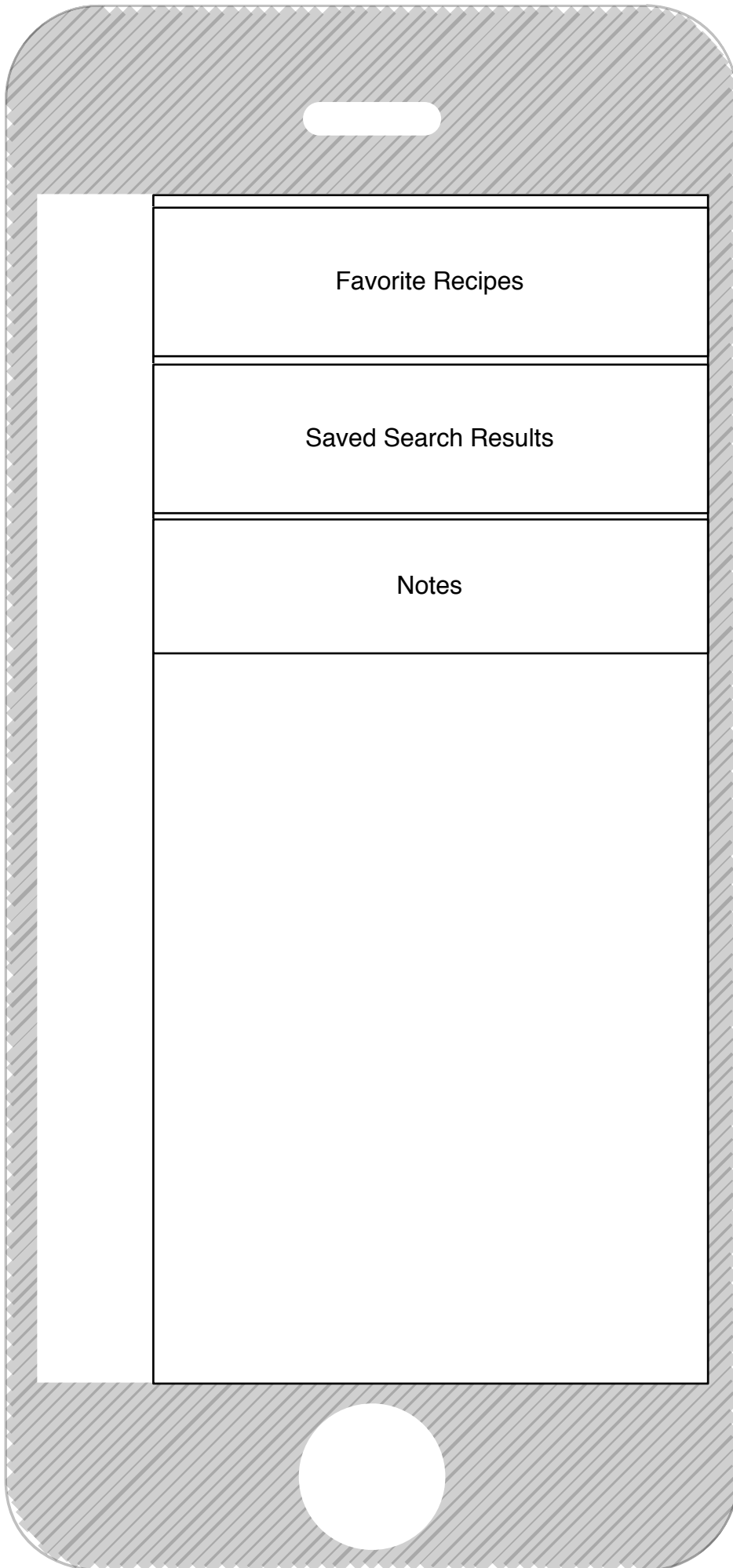
This modal view will pop up from bottom, eclipsing most of the screen but keeping info about the previous search at the top.



0.1 - Side swipe menu

Notes:

The side swipe menu is accessible by swiping to the left from the home screen. It will be translucent and will only eclipse about 3/4 of the screen. To return to the main screen, users can swipe to the right. The side swipe menu will be accessible from all screens throughout the app.



0.11, 0.12 and 0.13 Favorites, Saved Searches and Notes

All three screens have the same format. Users can swipe left to read and right to delete. Tapping will open the favorited recipe, search results or note.
